


Results as a chart: I am made to feel welcome when I come into school.




Results as a chart: I find it easy to approach the school with a question or problem.



Results as a chart: The school deals with any problems or issues raised.




Results as a chart: The school is well managed and well led.




Results as a chart: The school keeps me well informed of news and events (including on-line methods of communication).




Results as a chart: Parents are encouraged to be involved in the life of the school.




Results as a chart: The school has high expectations for all pupils to reach their full potential.




Results as a chart: Pupils are supported and challenged to extend their learning.
