New Behaviour Policy

We are currently reviewing our Behaviour and Positive Relationship Policy. The main difference your children will notice is that Golden Time and the Golden Pathway have been **replaced** by *Fun 31*. This relates to <u>Article 31</u> of The Convention on the Rights of the Child; all children have the right to play. Any misbehaviours will be dealt with throughout the week as they occur, rather than waiting for a Friday. As our new policy takes shape, we would appreciate your input. You will be kept fully informed if your child requires additional support following school rules. Thank you for your continued support as we aim to get it right for every child.

Wider Achievements

We will continue to celebrate all your child's achievements, whether these happen in school or not. This session we are introducing a new **Gold Book**, to help us keep track of all these success stories. A Nomination Form, to be included in this book, should be completed alongside an adult at home.
