### **PEF Update**



This year we have been granted £66,000 through the Pupil Equity Fund. Through analysis of our attainment results over recent years, it is evident that the most effective way for us to close our poverty related

attainment gap is by employing skilled staff who can support and challenge our learners. As a result, most of the money this year has been spent on employing an additional teacher and additional hours for an Additional Support Needs Assistant. In this way we can meet the needs of our learners in a more personalised way. Additional Maths resources have also been purchased in order to enhance our mental agility work, particularly at Early & First Level. We have also bought a range of assessments to help us analyse gaps in learning and how to best address these.

However, in order to promote Health & Wellbeing as you requested, we have also allocated funds towards upgrading our outdoor learning areas. We are delighted
