

Maths Factor Update

From now on, teachers will adjust the position on Maths Factor to reflect topics being covered in class. They won't assign specific lessons each week but the concept being taught in class will be the same as Maths Factor position so children can work through at their pace. Maths Factor only covers number concepts so if the class is covering measure, shape etc then the position won't be adjusted until the next number topic comes up. Here is an overview of our Numeracy and Maths topics for the year so you can see when key concepts are taught.



Digital Mornings

In order to encourage more pupils to use Maths Factor regularly, we are going to open our Digital Technologies room from 8.30am every morning from Monday onwards. This will be open to all Primary 5-7 pupils if they wish to come in early. Children should come to the front office from 8.30am where they will be taken to the Digital Tech room and will be supervised by a member of support staff or member of the leadership team. The aim is for children to complete one lesson in the morning before school starts and if they finish in time, they can rejoin friends in the playground. If they run slightly over 9am then they can go straight to class. We just wanted to provide an opportunity for children who may struggle to get time to complete Maths Factor at home due to various clubs and activities. The time can also be used to complete IDL sessions.

Attendance

We continue to have strong attendance figures, but our overall school attendance was down to 92% for December. Our percentages so far this session have been.

September - 97%

October - 95%

November - 95%

December - 92%

As a school our target is to stay above 95% so we will continue to work hard to maintain this standard. If children fall below 85% then we will be in contact with families to see if there is anything we can do to support getting children to school. If you have any concerns regarding your child's attendance, then please get in touch if there is anything you would like to discuss.
