What we are learning next

We will be continuing to build on the knowledge and skills we have already developed across curricular areas.

Literacy – Continuing to learn our initial sounds and common words. We will be using these words to help us build and create sentences with the aim of becoming much more independent when writing. We are going to continue to enjoy our reading books and using strategies to help us solve trickier words.

Maths – We will be continuing to work on our numbers to 10/20 and working on patterns using colour and shapes. Number formation will also be revised. Room 1 will also be introduced to addition and subtraction within 10, measure and looking at time.

Health and Wellbeing – Using the Emotion Works programme, we will be learning about the different coloured cogs and emotion words that will help us to describe how we are feeling.

Topic – We will be starting our topic called ‘Under the Sea’. This will provide many opportunities to take part in art, writing, creative activities, science and drama.

As always, we will be regularly referring to our 4 mindset characters. We try our best to be Determined like Dexter, Flexible like Flo, Curious like Ash and Brave like Astrid.
