Summary since August

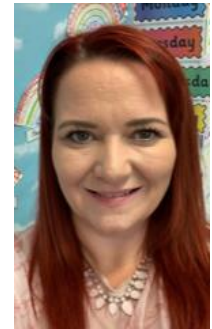
The boys and girls have been working very hard since settling back into school in August. Things have been very different for all of us, but we are all adapting well to the necessary changes! We have learned where to line up and which zone we can play in.

We have been revising the initial sounds and phonemes that we learned before lockdown and we are now moving forward with learning the remainder of the Stage 1 phonemes. We have also been revising common words, capital letters and full stops, finger spaces and letter formation.

In Numeracy, we have been working on addition and subtraction within 20 while practicing number formation and order. We also have worked on place value to 20, ordering numbers and missing numbers.

Summary Continued . . .

In Health and Wellbeing, we have been taking part in Outdoor P.E. and following rules on how to stay safe. We have discussed our lockdown memories and the different experiences we had during this time. We have also been thinking about our feelings and emotions through Emotion Works. Our topic has been Weather and the Water Cycle and the children have been learning some very technical words, such as precipitation and condensation!

What we are learning next

In **Literacy**, Room 4 will be continuing to work on Stage 1 phonemes. We will be working on writing more independently and carrying out a range of tasks linked to our reading books. In reading, we will be developing our pace and fluency and reading with expression. We will continue to learn new common words each week, using our spelling strategies. We will also continue to work on letter formation and developing our handwriting skills, including writing letters on the line. In **Numeracy and Maths**, we will continue to work on place value, addition and subtraction within number to 20 and number patterns. We will explore shape and also data handling. We will continue to develop skills within problem solving.

In **IDL**, we will be learning about Antarctica and continuing our research on weather both here and in Antarctica.
