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and spelling programme.

What we are learning next

We will continue to consolidate knowledge of number bonds and tables facts and explore a range of mental and written strategies to help with addition and subtraction of numbers up to 100 and beyond. We will look at symmetry and turning through angles. We will also introduce division and practise solving word problems.

In literacy we will explore a range of reading strategies through our reading books and work on phonics, spelling and handwriting. We will remember to use capitals and full stops and focus more on question, explanation and speech marks. We will practise writing instructions and explanations.

We will continue to look at growth mindset and getting to know our characters more. We will try our best and we will also explore what triggers us to feel a certain way.

We have recently introduced Class Dojo points and will be working hard to earn them.
