Summary since September

Literacy

In reading we have been developing our pace and fluency, thinking about punctuation marks and how this helps us to read with expression.

We have been developing our comprehension skills by learning to answer questions using our Find It, Prove It, Talk about It strategy. We have also been working on retelling the story orally and in written form.

We have been looking at different phoneme families and common words and the different spelling strategies we can use to help us spell these words. We have been using our pink boards and our SAY/MAKE/BREAK/BLEND/READ/WRITE strategy when learning new words.

In writing we have developed our writing skills using punctuation marks and joining words. We have learned to write instructions and acrostic poems.

We have continued to work on handwriting, letter size and letter formation.

Summary Continued . . . **Numeracy and Mathematics**

In Numeracy and Mathematics we have be learning about

Place Value- Reading, writing, ordering numbers to 100 and 1000

Addition and Subtraction- We have learned how to add and subtract tens and units (without carrying/exchanging)

Estimation and Rounding- We have learned how to round two/three digit numbers to the nearest 10.

Multiplication and Division- We have been learning to multiply and divide by 2, 5 and 10.

Money- We have been looking at different coins and notes to £10 and calculating amounts to £2

Problem Solving- We have been learning to read word problems and what calculations it is asking us to carry out.

What we are learning next

We will continue to work on our comprehension skills, using Find It, Prove It, Talk about It strategy. We will also continue to develop our writing skills in retelling the story in our own words and writing a summary of what the story is about. We will carry to work on our handwriting skills, thinking about the size of our letters, formation of our letters and the position of our letters on the line.

In writing we will start to look at the genres report and narrative writing. We will look at the different features needed to write a report and a narrative. As well as this we will focus on our writing targets:

- to use capital letters and full stops when writing sentences
- to join sentences using a variety of conjunctions/connectives
- to spell most common and tricky words correctly.
- to use paragraphs to separate events/ideas/facts

We will continue to look at phonemes and common words each week, using different spelling strategies to help spell these words.

- Money to £10.00
- Properties of shape
