Summary since September

Literacy

Spelling – Pupils will continue in their spelling groups working on spelling strategies and building vocabulary.

Reading – We have studied The Boy in the Dress as part of our fiction block. We have also studied non-fiction looking at Dinosaurs and Ancient Egypt. We are now exploring media through Christmas adverts, analysing themes and techniques used to influence the viewer.

Writing – The children have been working on persuasive, poetry, discursive, information reports and narrative.

Numeracy

Since October the class have been working on BODMAS, angles, long multiplication and division, fractions, decimals and percentages, multiples, factors and primes and money. The pupils have also been exploring Mental Agility with a focus on subtraction strategies.

Health and Wellbeing

This term pupils have been exploring the themes of Healthy, Achieving and Nurtured. They have looked at substance misuse, ambitions for careers in the food industry and creating a nurturing ethos for the playground through Rights Respecting Schools. In PE we have been exploring a variety of team games.

IDL

Room 20 have been learning about The Rainforest. They have been developing their research skills, as well as linking their learning with skills learned across the curriculum.

What we are learning next

- In Literacy next term we will be looking at novels. One of these novels will link in with previous work undertaken on sectarianism with Holy Family and Nil by Mouth. In writing we will continue our work on discursive and narrative texts as well as introducing recounts. We will also focus on writing techniques including grammar and punctuation. The spelling programme will continue to run with weekly spell checks to assess progress.
- In maths and numeracy next term we will be covering algebra, area, measurement and probability. We will also continue to use Mental Agility to build confidence and skills with a focus on multiplication.
- In IDL next term pupils will be focusing on Scotland and linking this with themes from their literacy novels. They will also explore Significant Scots.
- In HWB next term children will be exploring the themes of Active, Respected and Responsible. In PE we will be focusing on Athletics.
