<u>Staff Updates</u>

At this time of year a lot of work goes behind the scenes at our Local Authority in terms of staffing for next session. As soon as our staffing is confirmed we will then be able to subsequently confirm our classes and structures for next session. We will share this information with you as soon as we have it.









Attendance and Lateness

Attendance continues to be a strong priority across our authority, and nationally. At Mossend PS we are monitoring attendance closely, and working alongside partner agencies to support families in improving this. By the end of February our average attendance was sitting at 91.5% which falls below the local authority average of 95%.

Please see the attached table for average attendance per stage and see where our biggest concerns lie. There is a direct link between attendance and attainment and we cannot stress the importance of good attendance for your children.

We would be grateful if you could ensure that your child arrives at school for their start time so they do not miss key teaching and learning and teaching.

A reminder of our school uniform, there are no plans to amend this for next session.


Formal Uniform

P1 Transition

Our transition programme continues this month as we continue with 'Our Getting to Know You' sessions. In May, buddies will start to visit the children in their nurseries and class visits will begin the week beginning the 3^{rd} of June.

Mossend nursery children and Primary One pupils will participate in a joint Teddy Bear Picnic to raise funds for St Andrew's Hospice on the 15th May and a joint Sports Day will be held on the 28th May.





<u>Water Bottles</u>

Since the implementation of the Single Use Plastics Ban (2022), we are unable to provide pupils with plastic cups throughout the school day for a drink of water.

As the warmer weather approaches, please ensure your child comes to school with a water bottle.

Pupils will have access to water throughout the school day to fill up their bottles.









Parent Consultation 3 - Thursday 6th June

Our final parent consultations will take place on Thursday 6th June. The focus for this final meeting will be a progress update and planning for transition.

At this consultation you will be provided with a brief paper overview of levels of attainment for your child for key curricular areas. This will be much less detailed than a traditional end-of-year report due to our 3rd face-to-face meeting with a teacher this session.

Bookings will be made via the online Parent Booking System. Bookings will go live at 8pm on Tuesday 28th May and will close on Tuesday 4th June, also at 8pm.



Appointments (Reminder)

Where possible, appointments should be made out with the school day. If this is not possible then an appointment letter should be produced in advance of when your child needs to be excused from class time. Please call in advance and inform us of appointments.

We have an increasing number of children with afternoon appointments, particularly on a Friday. This can be disruptive to learning, and to the running of the school through unplanned office interruptions at busy times.

We appreciate your understanding with this.









Health and Wellbeing

During the month of May, the Healthy in Schools programme will focus on the wellbeing indicator of 'Included'. Through Early, First and Second Level children will participate in activities such as differences and similarities, self-esteem, personal values and the role that family and friends play in our own wellbeing.

In June we will focus on Relationships Sexual Health & Parenthood (RSHP). This will be taught in stages (P1-7). We take guidance from the Scottish Government on how to deliver this sensitively using the following website which sits in line with curriculum for excellence. <u>Home - RSHP</u>

Mrs Brownlie will run a parent drop in session on Tuesday the 14th of May to discuss any queries prior to lessons commencing.





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Mossend Nursery Class

In Term 3 children will **experience** the use of money in different contexts and begin to become familiar with the language of sharing and fractions. Children will develop their knowledge of living things in the environment and will help grow and learn about different plants and flowers.

As part of our transition, all Nursery children will participate in Teddy Bear Picnic with Primary 1 children. This is part of an annual fundraiser to support St. Andrew's Hospice. We recognise that a recent sponsor has recently taken place and have asked St. Andrew's Hospice if we can share a just giving link rather than giving out sponsor forms. We are very much looking forward to our annual Nursery outing on the 14th June to Blair Drummond Safari Park.










Physical Education (Reminder)

We continue to ensure that our children receive their 2 hour entitlement of physical education each week. This comprises of 1 hour of indoor PE, and 1 hour of outdoor PE. On these days we would appreciate your support in ensuring that long hair is tied back, jewellery is removed, and children have their water bottles with them.

In relation to new piercings, these must be covered with a plaster either prior to coming to school, or children need to apply themselves in school. This is in accordance with NLC guidelines to ensure that children can access their entitlement safely.
