SYLLABIFICATION AND RHYME



Teacher uses familiar Nursery Rhymes



Rhyme encourages children to pay attention to the sound structure of words while working on listening skills.



Focus on the awareness of syllables in words and then move on to smaller units of sound in words.

ALLITERATION AND ALPHABET

Children are introduced to letters (2 per week)

Identify and produce words with the same initial sound

5 finger approach (Say, Make/Break, Blend, Read and Write)

READING



Children will receive 2 reading books per week from October.



Children will have been taught the book by the Class Teacher.



Read the book at home, remembering to talk about concepts of print, what is happening in the picture, look at words they might know and help with tricky words.
