Attendance and Lateness

Attendance continues to be a strong priority across our authority, and nationally. At Mossend PS we are monitoring attendance closely, and working alongside partner agencies to support families in improving this.

There is a direct link between attendance and attainment and we cannot stress the importance of good attendance for your children.

We would be grateful if you could ensure that your child arrives at school for their start time so they do not miss key teaching and learning.

If you are needing to report pupil absence, this can be done via Parents Portal. If you are planning to phone the school, please call after 8.15am as the office is not staffed until 8.15am.



School Uniform for Session 2024/2025

We would like to say a huge thank you to our families for once again supporting our uniform policy. We are so proud of how smart the children look with almost all children wearing the appropriate uniform each day. A reminder of our uniform policy:

Formal Uniform

- Royal blue jumpers and cardigans (school branding optional)
- · White shirt and tie
- · Grey trousers/pinafores/skirts
- · Blue Tartan pinafores/skirts

Please note, the colour black is <u>not</u> in line with the school's uniform policy.

PE Kit

- · Royal blue hoodie or jumper
- White t-shirt/polo shirt
- Black leggings, shorts or joggers

Children will be permitted to come to school wearing their PE Kit on gym days (twice per week) as long as they are in correct formal school uniform on the other 3 days

Nursery Uniform (Uniform is not compulsory for nursery children)

Royal blue polo shirt and sweatshirt or own clothes.

Appointments (Reminder)

Where possible, appointments should be made out with the school day. If this is not possible then an appointment letter should be produced in advance of when your child needs to be excused from class time. Please call in advance and inform us of appointments.

We have an increasing number of children with afternoon appointments, particularly on a Friday. This can be disruptive to learning, and to the running of the school through unplanned office interruptions at busy times.

We appreciate your understanding with this.





Inclement Weather

At this point of the year, it is vital that we all prepare for the possibility of inclement weather. Please familiarise yourself with our adverse weather arrangements for the winter months.

- The school must remain open, unless instructed to close by the Local Authority.
- In the event of a school closure, parents will be notified by text message, and via X. It is essential that emergency contact details are up to date and accurate for every child. Please see the school office if there have been any changes to your own details.
- In severe weather, e.g. heavy ice and snow, then there will only be one access point to the school, which will be via the main gate.
- The school facilities staff are responsible for clearing a safe path through the school grounds to the access doors, however please note that public paths around the school, do not fall under the responsibility of the school.

Note, that in the event of school closure learning will be made available digitally via Microsoft Teams. North Lanarkshire Council also have a wealth of resources on the Digital School which can be accessed via Glow, your child's teacher will be able to advise you which colour of the digital resources is suitable to complete. 


Pupils' Book Recommendations

Christmas Parties
