




Second Level Maths & Numeracy Home Activities

Research a famous mathematician. How did they impact the world?




Create a multiplication/division board game. Play it with your family.

Estimate the perimeter and area of your garden or local park in metres. Convert it to cm and mm.




Log on to Sumdog. How many questions can you answer correctly?
