## **Adverse Weather Activities for Primary 1**



- Practise writing words with your sounds in them: sh, ch, th, ng
- Find things outside beginning with any sound you have learned. (a z)
- Listen to the Jolly Phonics song.
- Can you find 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, and 8 letter words in a reading book?
- Read a story with someone, can you discuss what happened at the beginning, middle and end? Can you say who is in the story and where the story took place?
- Play a game of snap with your common words. If you shout "snap" make sure to read the common word.
- Practise writing numbers to 20 and beyond.
- Can you make up and answer addition and subtraction sums within 10.
- Go on a shape hunt. What shapes did you find?
- Empty your piggy bank. Can you sort the coins?
- Make two models. Which one is the tallest?
- Draw a picture of what you can see from your window.
- Design your own castle?
- Create your own superhero.
- Make a scary Loch monster.
