What is the purpose of the Virtual Classroom?




The purpose of the Virtual Classroom is to provide learners with high quality digital learning resources. These can be used within the classroom as a teaching resource or used by learners at home.

Accessing via Glow

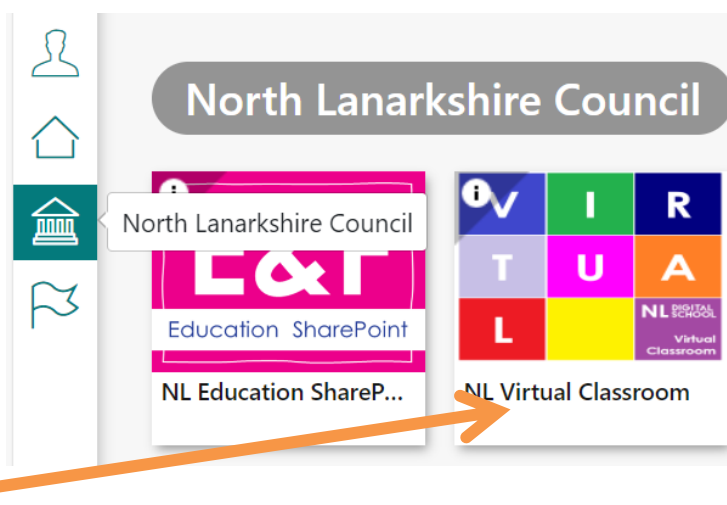

Downloading resources (Laptop)



When you find a resource to work on, it must be downloaded before you can use it. To do this, select:

File → **Save as** → **Download a Copy**

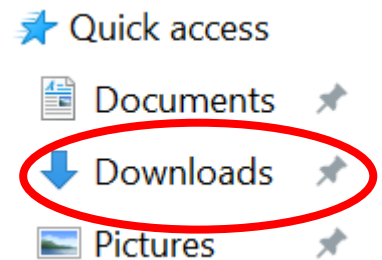
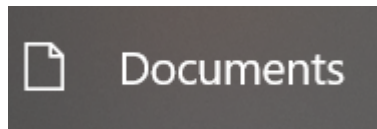
Opening resources (Laptop)



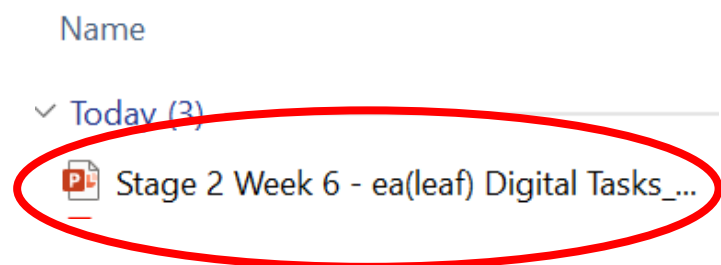
The resource will now be on your child's device. To access it, they will need to find the '**Downloads**' folder.

Windows → **Documents** → **Downloads**



They should now see their resource in the folder. Double click to open.



They can now use and edit the resource as required.



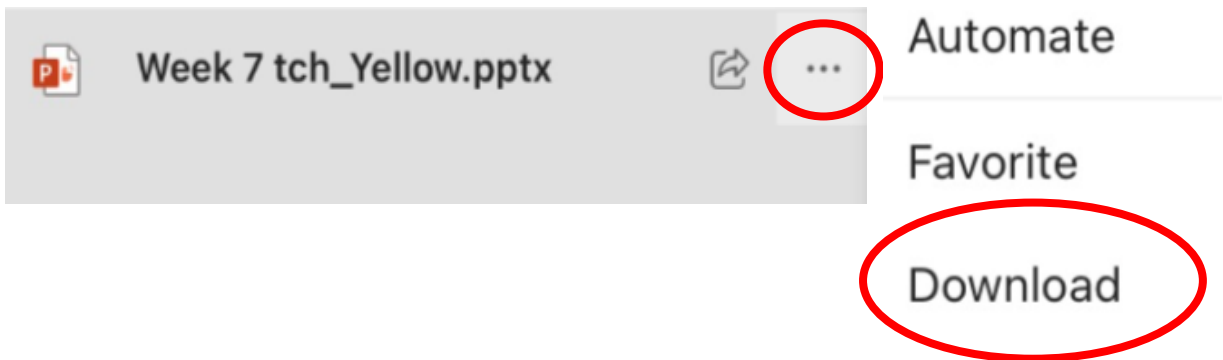

Downloading Resources (iPad)

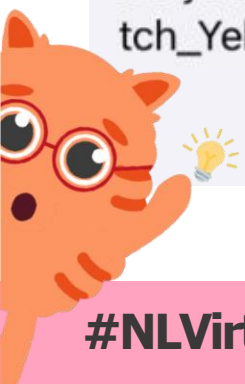
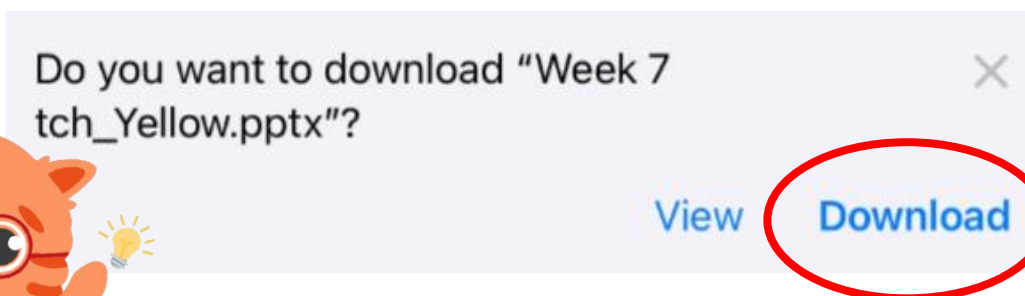


When your child finds a resource to work on, it must be downloaded before they can use it. To do this, select:

Three dots on the resource(...) → Download



Then, confirm by clicking 'Download' again

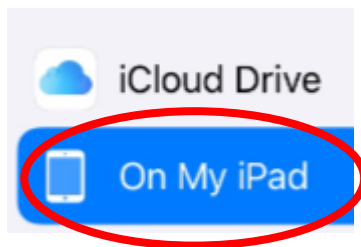
Opening Resources (iPad)

Things To Remember



- If your child doesn't know their Glow login details, they should ask **their teacher** for support.
- If your child doesn't know their Classroom Colour, **ask their teacher** for support.
