- PEF money has been used to partly support staffing numbers and in addition to NLC direct funding this had allowed an additional 1FTE of staff (Miss Agnew). As a result

of this, Mrs Hendry and Miss Grier have then been able to be used to target support and help with Covid recovery.

- P7 Strathclyde Park experience will be paid for again by the school at a total cost of £2376 from the budget.
- The school/nursery improvement plan for this year can be found on the website.
- New Staff - There are two new members of staff this year, Miss Craig (probationer) and Miss Brannan. Mr Walker is our new janitor.
