Participating in outdoor activities also improves the health and wellbeing of young people and encourages them to work as a team, learn new skills and really feel part of the action in an outdoor setting.

All schools will be supported by a team of Active Schools Coordinators across North Lanarkshire to develop skills and activities.

School trips will be over a five-day programme and the achievements of all pupils participating will be recognised and celebrated throughout the week.
