We are leading up to the time of the year when people start thinking about planning and booking holidays. I would ask that you book holidays in school holidays rather than taking children out of the school during term time.

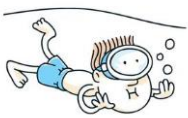


Winter Weather

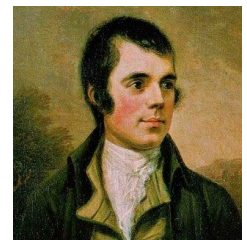
CSI Bellshill– Bellshill Academy
