Dear Parents,

In the meantime, if you have any questions or queries please do not hesitate to get in touch.



# Outdoor Area Update

We are fully committed to developing our school grounds and have recently applied for Tesco's Bags for Life for some extra funding. Our plan is to develop the playground with some permanent physical activities and also purchase a Polycrub, which is a sturdier version of a Polytunnel, so that the children can plant and grow their own vegetables. However, we recognise that these plans take time. In the meantime, we would like to thank the Co-op Distribution Centre at Newhouse for helping us to tidy up and reorganise our outdoor garden. When finished, this area will be well used by our children particularly during playful learning activities.


#### Parking

#### <u>Sum Dog – Maths Resource</u>


