Mr Scott, Depute Head Teacher will visit the school on Friday 16th November to meet P7 parents, to discuss transition arrangements to Bellshill Academy.

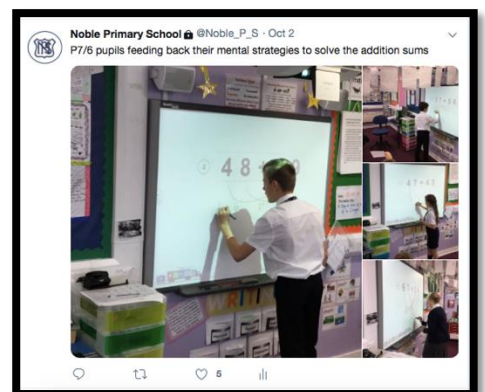


Primary 6 Songwriting Project

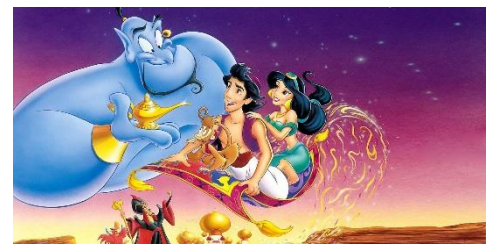
Mary's Meals - Back Pack Appeal

We recently had a speaker from Mary's Meals to tell the pupils of all the work they do around the world. The Backpack Project is a simple way to help children from poor families to get to school in countries like Liberia and Malawi. Very often these families cannot afford to buy basic things like pencils and notebooks, or even suitable clothes to wear to school, and so children miss out on an education. Along with the free school meal that Mary's Meals provides (costing as little as £6.15 per child, per year) the backpacks we are planning to send, help children to get an education that will help them escape poverty in later life.

We are taking part in the Backpack Project, and we are looking for any old school bags that you may have and would ask that pupils bring them into the school.
