**Staffing Update**

**Test and Protect Protocols**

We will contact you if your child displays these symptoms. Our guidance states that children showing symptoms should be tested. The family should self-isolate until the test results have been received.

**Start of Day Arrangements**

In inclement weather, you may wish to drop off the children closer to their starting time.
