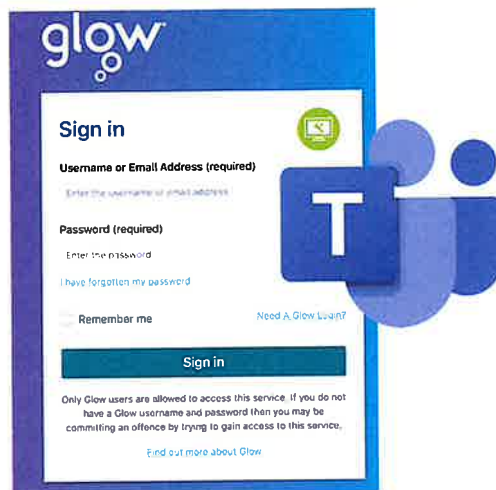
## Accessing Digital Learning through Glow and MS Teams

Our main learning platform will be Microsoft Teams. Your child has been issued with their own unique username and password.

Your child can download most Microsoft apps for free using their Glow email and password.

## Using Sumdog

All children at Noble Primary School, have free access to Sumdog. This can be accessed through the website or downloaded as an app. Teachers can monitor the children's access and progress. Teachers have remote access to set work appropriate to their level. If you need your child's password reset, their teachers will be able to do this for them.





### Learning Digitally

Since the start of this year, all home learning has been posted online to work on at home so the children should be able to access Teams by now. There will be work available daily on your child's class team. For the first week, we will send you a weekly overview through email. Teachers will also post information on the general chat channel. There will be a teacher online every day to offer support and to check in with pupils. We will also post activities that are not screen based.

### Digital Learning and In School Provision

Some teaching staff will be needed to teach children attending school during the school day. Class Teachers will work with a partner teacher who will offer support online when they are working in school. We plan to make good use of the interactive resources available to ensure the learning is engaging and progressive for all children. We will be asking for the children's views in the next few weeks so that we can adapt our provision accordingly.

The children working in school will access the same digital learning offer as those working at home.

Things to note:

- It is important that all children participate in the learning provided.
- New work will be tailored to the groups your child works in.
- Teachers will use a variety of tools to introduce new learning.
- Children's work should be uploaded so the teacher can provide feedback.
- Some lessons or tasks may be whole class.
- A mix of online and offline activities will be planned for.
- Teachers will be available through the day with live check-ins, **however**, this may vary if staff are working in school to teach key worker children.
- Jotters are available from school so please let us know what you need.



Finally, there is no pressure to complete tasks every day. We know how difficult things can be at home. We ask that you do the best you can, and learning can be completed at any time of the day.

We will be in contact with you if your child has not uploaded work or has taken part in the Teams check ins. We want to ensure the very best progress is made during this difficult time. We have access to a range of supports for families, so please contact us and we will sign post you as best we can to the right service. Ultimately, we are here to help in any way we can.
