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Dear Parents/Carers,

We have been very busy over the last few days, organising our in school arrangements for those eligible to attend school, and to plan for digital learning. We appreciate your patience and understanding during this time, as we begin to set up the tandem systems. I will outline our current plans and procedures but must stress that plans will no doubt change as we progress.

In School Learning

School provision is only to be accessed when there is no alternative provision. To qualify for keyworker provision, both parents must be keyworkers, who cannot work from home. Proof of this should be submitted to the school as soon as possible. Attendance of keyworker children should be kept to an absolute minimum to help control the spread of the coronavirus.

Currently, we are planning to reconfigure class bubbles. This means your child will be part of a new class bubble, where contact with others will be limited and managed, in accordance with our risk assessments and mitigations. Teaching staff will be part of a rota so that we can provide in school learning and digital learning. When your child's class teacher is in school, another member of staff will monitor their Microsoft Team.

Children attending school must wear their uniform, bring a snack, and be prepared to be outdoors. Lunch provision will run as normal.

For Monday 11th January, our class bubbles will be as follows:

Class Bubble A - Any child attending from P1, P2/1, P2 enter the school gate from Baird Place Gate at 9am and line up in the Red Zone. The children will be dismissed from there at 3pm. Teacher on Monday will be Miss Mitchell.

Class Bubble B - Any child attending from P3, P4/3 should enter through Baird Place Gate at 9am and line up in the Yellow Zone. The children will be dismissed from the front door entrance at 3pm. Teacher on Monday will be Miss Shields.

Class Bubble C - Any child attending from P5/4 and P5 should enter from Fleming Road Gate and line up in the Green Zone at 9am. The children will be dismissed from here at 3pm. Teacher on Monday will be Mrs Malcolmson.

Class Bubble D - Any child attending from P6/5a, P6/5b, P7a, P7b should enter from Fleming Road Gate and line up at the Blue Zone. The children will be dismissed from here at 3pm. Teacher on Monday will be Mrs Montgomery.

As always, if you are collecting your child at the school gate or main entrance, please remember to socially distance and wear a face covering. Staff will manage dismissal in a safe way.

Please be aware that our class bubbles may have to be changed. This depends on the number of children accessing the school. We will let you know if this is necessary in due course.

At Home Digital Learning

Our main platform for learning will be through Microsoft Teams. Teachers have been using Microsoft Teams to set homework through-out the year, so the majority of the children should be able to access this easily. I have produced an overview of our arrangements for you to look over. We are at the other end of the telephone, should you need any help or support.

What do to next...

- Your child should log on to Glow, Microsoft Teams and Sumdog to ensure he/she has access for Monday. Contact us today if you need any passwords reset. We would ask your child to store their log in details securely.
- We issued a digital access survey a few months ago. I will be reissuing this today and would appreciate if you could complete it as soon as possible.
- Let us know if you need any help in any way and we will do our best to support. Emails from parents should be directed to enquiries@noble.n-lanark.sch.uk

We will be in contact with you if your child is not taking part in the digital offer to identify any other supports we can put in place. Again, I want to stress that we are here to help in any way we can.

Accessing Glow on Your Console

Did you know that pupils can access Glow on their gaming consoles? This might help free up home laptops or devices for parents who are also seeking to work from home. It may not be available on all console formats but this guide will help Xbox and PlayStation users.

For Xbox users:



1. Turn on Xbox One and launch Edge*
2. Enter the URL <https://glow.rmunify.com>.
3. Once loaded enter you or your child's username (this will be the part before @glow.sch.uk).
4. Enter the password.
(Optional) You can choose to save the username and password on the browser for easier access next time.
