## Wet Mornings

We are still unable to accommodate the children indoors before school starts. In inclement weather, you may wish to drop off your child as near to their start time as possible.

## Drop Off & Collection

We have staggered start times for classes to ease congestion at the gates. A member of staff will be there to support the children on entry. We are now using the main entrance gate leading on to Shirrel Avenue, as an exit gate for P7 pupils only. A member of staff will supervise the children at this gate. **We would politely ask you to drop off your child/ren at the gate and leave as quickly as you can. Senior staff are in the playground, supervising.**

Scottish Government has asked all schools to remind parents to observe 2m distancing and to wear a face covering at all times, unless you are exempt. If you need to speak to a teacher, please telephone the school.

## Playtimes

Playtimes will continue to be staggered. Each class has to remain within their own class bubble. This is for track and trace purposes. Each class will continue to have their own allocated area in the playground. This was already in place before the recent lockdown.

## Breakfast Club Arrangements

From 15<sup>th</sup> March 2021, Breakfast Club will reopen for all families to use. Please ensure you arrive between 8:15am and 8:45am.

Please use the over spill car park for drop off and do not leave cars parked on the yellow line. This will be monitored by Facility Support Staff.

## Uniform

Our uniform arrangements remain the same for this term. The children can wear black jogging bottoms or black leggings instead of trousers/skirts. School shirts, polo shirts and jumpers to be worn as normal. The children will continue to utilise the outdoor space as much as they can. We hope to be able to identify a safe place for storing wellies for outdoor learning. We will let you know these arrangements soon. The children must come to school with a warm, waterproof jacket every day. P.E will continue to be outside and pupils should come prepared on these days for the outdoors.

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## Items from Home

A reminder that the children must not bring any toys or other unnecessary items from home.

## School Bags

The children should continue to bring a school bag containing their morning snack, water bottle and packed lunch.

## Mobile Phones

If your child brings a phone to school it must be switched off before entering the playground. Mobile phones should be kept in school bags at all times - these are left in bags at your child's own risk and school staff cannot accept responsibility for them.

Like you, I am hopeful that this will be the last lockdown we have due to the coronavirus. We are looking forward to having all of the children back in our school safely.
