Literacy and English

This term the pupils in Primary 7A will be writing explanations and discursive pieces. They will also continue to write narratives and have opportunities to write across the curriculum.

Core Target emphasis will focus on using spelling strategies to spell most words correctly and to spell topic words with more accuracy and independence. The children will also continue to use NLC Active Literacy Programme and the 6 Strategies of Comprehension. This will include prior knowledge, metalinguistics, visualiser, inference, main idea and summary of the novel being read in class and at home.

Numeracy and Mathematics

The pupils will be experiencing a variety of concepts this term including; measurement and angles and chance.

Number work will continue throughout the term mentally and in written form and will focus on multiplication and division strategies.





Health and Wellbeing

The 2 hours of Outdoor PE per week will include playing ball games, class games and circuits.

<u>Healthy:</u> Pupils will be discussing Healthy Lifestyles which will include the importance of mental wellbeing and how this can be strengthened through personal coping skills and positive relationships and actions to help someone in an emergency. <u>R.R.S.A.</u>: The Rights of the Child being looked at this term will be Article 31, right to play, Article 15, the right to meet with other children and join groups and organisations, and Article 32, Governments must protect children from work that is dangerous.

<u>Resilience:</u> Pupils will be learning about resilience by following the Building Resilience Pack to promote emotional health and wellbeing, concentrating on 'Challenging Your Mindset'.

Interdisciplinary Learning

Pupils will be learning about 'Climate Change' and 'Scottish Landscapes'.





Pupils will be learning about Esther and the Jewish festival of Purim.

French & Spanish

We will be continuing to revise French vocabulary and learn Spanish foods and animals.

Home Learning

There will be weekly reading to complete relating to class novel.
