Dear Parent/Carer,

By now, your child should have received their invitation to our transition event on Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup> May. Unfortunately, we have been monitoring the weather over the last few days, and it looks likely, that we will have to reorganise our arrangements for Wednesday's visit outside, due to the wet weather forecast. We have therefore, taken the decision to invite the children into the school building on Wednesday to work in our Rainbow Room. However, in line with recently updated Scottish Government guidance for transitions, we have been advised to reduce footfall to the school building, parents are asked to drop off and pick up again 45/50mins later.

I understand this is a change to our initial arrangements, but we feel it is important to go ahead with the visit rather than postpone it.

Our arrangements for Wednesday are as follows:

- Arrive at the Baird Place gate with your child at your allocated time.
- A member of staff will be there to direct you.
- Please hand over any paper work you have completed to a member of staff.
- Bring along your child's 'Design a Bear' activity.
- Your child will work in the Rainbow Room, in a small group, with Miss Mitchell and Mrs Murphy.
- Collect your child from the playground after 45/50 minutes.
- We will share the children's work on our twitter account @NobleTransition.

Please note, there will be staff on hand if your child becomes upset and we will work with you to manage this.

Parents are reminded to wear a face covering and observe 2m social distancing at all times. Due to these mitigations, only one parent/carer should accompany each child.
