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

#### Welcome Back

I hope everyone has had a fantastic summer holiday and looking forward to the new term at Noble Primary School. You will have received a letter from our Executive Director of Education detailing the arrangements for schools returning in August. Please read this alongside this newsletter. Almost all of our mitigations will remain in place until we are instructed otherwise by Scottish Government and North Lanarkshire Council. I have put together a summary of our arrangements for returning to school below which I hope you find useful. Please do not hesitate to contact the school if you have any questions or queries.



# Drop Off & Collection

We continue to have staggered start times for classes to ease congestion at the gates. A member of staff will be there to support the children on entry and exit. We would politely ask you to drop off your child/ren at the gate and leave as quickly as you can. Senior staff are in the playground, supervising.

Any parent at the school gate must observe 2m social distancing and wear a face covering at all times, unless exempt.

If you need to speak to a teacher, please telephone the school. Parents are not permitted in the playground.

# Uniform and PE

The children can now wear the normal school uniform. Primary 1 to 6 grey trousers or skirt, blue cardigan or sweatshirt, white polo shirt, white shirt & tie. Primary 7 black trousers or skirt, black cardigan or sweatshirt, white polo shirt, white shirt & tie. P7 ties are available to purchase from the school office at a cost of £4.50.

On PE days, the children must come to school wearing their PE kit, which should consist of black/grey jogging bottoms/leggings instead of trousers/skirts, polo shirt with school jumper. The children must come to school with a warm, waterproof jacket every day. We will continue to use the outdoor areas as much as possible, in line with Scottish Government guidance.

## **Playtimes**

#### Cost of School Dinner

A school meal costs £3.10 per day. Please use the ipay system to top up and monitor your child's account ensuring there is sufficient funds to cover the cost of the meal.

# Breakfast Club Arrangements

Breakfast Club will reopen for all families to use on Monday  $16^{th}$  August. All P1-3 pupils, and those eligible for free school meals, are able to access a free breakfast. For all other pupils the cost is £1 per day with a sliding scale for families of two at £1.50 per day and families of three at £1.80 per day.

Please ensure your child arrives between 8:15am and 8:35am. Children should not attend Breakfast Club if they are not getting a breakfast.

#### Items from Home

The children must not bring any toys or other unnecessary items from home to school. The children will continue to have their own pack of pens and pencils to use in class so do not need to bring anything from home.

## School Bags

The children should continue to bring a school bag containing their morning snack, water bottle and packed lunch.
