As you will be aware, we have received updated guidance from Scottish Government and North Lanarkshire Council in relation to Covid 19. Classes on the ground and first floor will be dismissed at 2.55pm, to ease congestion at the gate. I have outlined further changes below.

## Changes to Start Times

All classes will start at 8:55am. The school yard will be supervised by support staff and leadership team from 8:45am. The children can use the Baird Place or Fleming Road Gates to access the playground. There is no longer a requirement to have separate entrances in the morning.
