Literacy and English



What will we be learning?

Reading:

We will be using punctuation and grammar to read with understanding and expression. We will be able to identify the main idea of a text, ask, and answer questions to help make sense of a text.

Writing:

We will continue to write narrative texts throughout the term by looking at change stories using story maps. We will have the opportunity to explore nonfiction writing and will be able to select, organise and include relevant information in various written texts.

Talking and Listening:

We will be given the opportunity to listen and contribute to group and class discussions.

Numeracy and Maths

What will we be learning?

We will be learning about fractions using concrete materials, looking at different symbols for equations and telling the time using analogue and digital clocks.

Our number work will continue, and we will be learning to apply strategies to multiply and divide using the 2,3,4,5 and 10 times tables.

We will be learning some of our Numeracy and Maths in the Outdoor Classroom and will be consolidating our learning using SUMDOG.



Health and Wellbeing

What will we be learning?



PE Focus: Our PE days are now Mondays and Tuesdays and this term we will be learning about Orienteering, Racquet Sports and Outdoor games.

Building Resilience: This term's focus will be 'Expect the Unexpected'. We will consider how change is a part of life and things change at some point.

Right of the Month: We will be exploring Articles 40, 17, and 29 this term. We will investigate juvenile justice, accessing information from the media safely and goals of education.
