### Literacy and English



#### What will we be learning?

##### Reading:

We will be continuing to use the Find it! Prove it! Talk about it! Strategy as well as being Text Detectives. Some aspects of the NLC 6 Strategies of Comprehension have been introduced and will continue this term.

##### Writing:

We will be writing more narrative genres this term. The focus will be on 'portal and change stories.' We will continue learning to include character and scene description, as well as thoughts and feelings in our writing. We will continue to carefully check all core targets after every piece of written work.



##### Talking and Listening:

We will be learning to communicate clearly and audibly and contribute to group/class discussions by engaging with others for a range of purposes. We will learn to select and share ideas/information using appropriate vocabulary in a logical order and use appropriate resources to engage with others, for example, objects, pictures and/or photographs.

## Numeracy and Maths

### What will we be learning?

We will be learning about measurement of length, area and capacity, fractions and data analysis.

Our number work will continue, and we will be learning to use the correct mathematical vocabulary when discussing the four operations of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

The focus on Number Talks will be revisiting the strategies learned for addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division.

We will be learning some of our Numeracy and Maths in the Outdoor Classroom and will be consolidating our learning using SUMDOG.



## Health and Wellbeing

### What will we be learning?



**PE Focus:** Our PE days are Mondays and Wednesdays and this term we will be learning playground activities including outdoor summer games, netball and athletics.

**Building Resilience:** This term's focus will be to 'Expect the Unexpected'. We will consider how to deal with changes in our lives and how to control our feelings when these changes occur.
