Literacy and English

What will we be learning?



Reading:

Pupils will have the opportunity to explore fiction novels and non-fiction texts linked with their IDL topics. They will be focusing on using NLC's 6 Comprehension Strategies to support their understanding of the text.

Writing:

Primary 4/5 will be focusing on writing **Narratives** (*Portal Stories and Change Tales*) **Recounts** and **Information Reports** linked with the pupils IDL topic, as well as having opportunities for writing across the curriculum. Pupils will continue to explore '**Short Burst Writing**' to help support their Narrative Writing targets.

Talking and Listening:

Pupils will have the opportunity to develop their presenting skills as they learn to new skills on how to project their voice, engage with an audience and perform in front of an audience as they prepare for their Rights Assembly.

Numeracy and Maths

What will we be learning?

Number Money and Measure

Within Maths this term, pupils will be exploring all concepts within **Information Handling**, such as, gathering and analysing data, selecting an appropriate method to sort and present their data e.g., pictographs, bar graphs, line graphs, pie charts and tally mark charts. Pupils will also be learning how compare data and relate this to the World of Work.

Pupils will also be learning about **Position and Movement**. They will be learning how to map out a journey, use a compass, use positional language, and plot co-ordinates on a grid. Additionally, pupils will be challenged on reading and interpreting a map and directions of their local community. Pupils will also continue with written and mental number work, which will include Addition, Subtraction, Multiplication and Division strategies within **Mental Agility**.



Health and Wellbeing

What will we be learning?



PE Focus:

Our PE days are **Wednesday** and **Thursday**. The focus for this term will be *Group and Team Games*. Pupils will be participating in a range of *Summer Games*. Additionally, pupils will be taking part in *Athletics* with a focus on running, jumping, throwing and monitoring their fitness levels.

Building Resilience:

This term pupils will be learning about 'Expect the Unexpected'. Pupils will be learning how to cope and manage change in their lives.

Right of the Month:

Pupils will be learning about *Article 40* this month. Pupils will be learning how they can be represented if the need legal help and not be discriminated against.

SHANARRI Focus:

Within Health and Wellbeing pupils will be focusing on *Responsible and Included*.

IDL and Topic Work

Social Studies:

This term pupils will be learning about The National Health System (NHS). They will be exploring the history of the NHS and the roles and responsibilities of NHS workers. Pupils will have the opportunity to explore the World of Work and the skills and qualities needed for NHS jobs.

Sciences:

This term the pupils Science topic will be **Scientific Discoveries**. Pupils will be learning to explore scientific discoveries that changed the world. They will have the opportunity to research, discuss and explore discoveries that they are interested in. Pupils will have an opportunity to recreate these within class.

Other Curricular Areas

Pupils will be focusing on their art and design skills, and will focus on tone, line and shading to create a range of artwork. Pupils will be using their writing themes to help them create drama scenes linked with their portal and change stories. Additionally, pupils will be learning to keep a beat of 4 and bringing in their own lyrics to the music they have selected.
