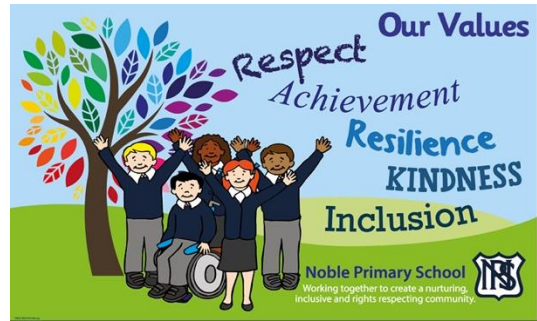

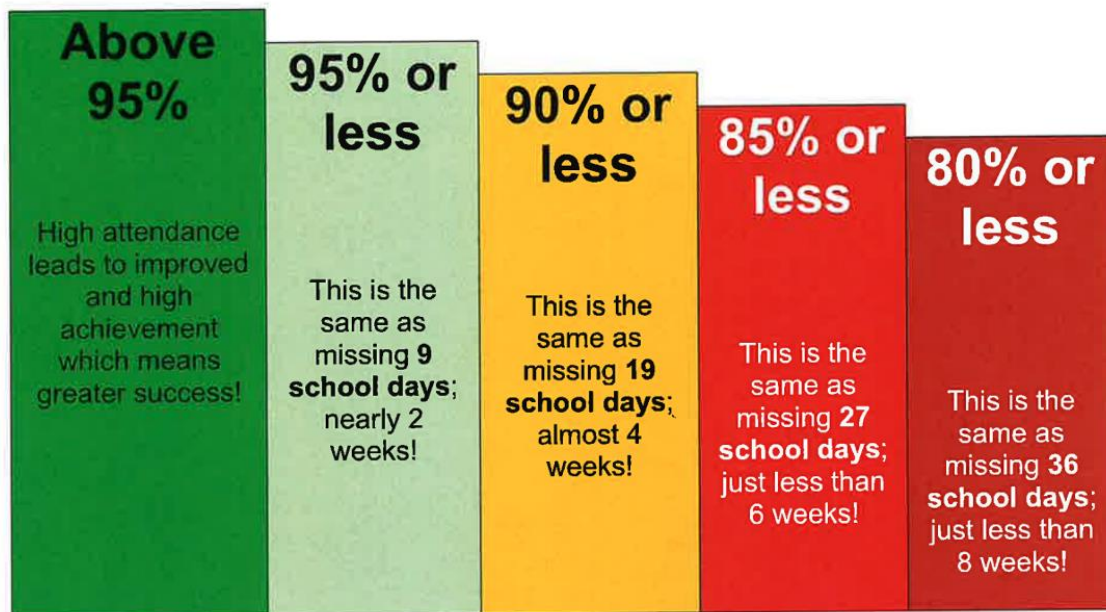
October: Right of the Month
