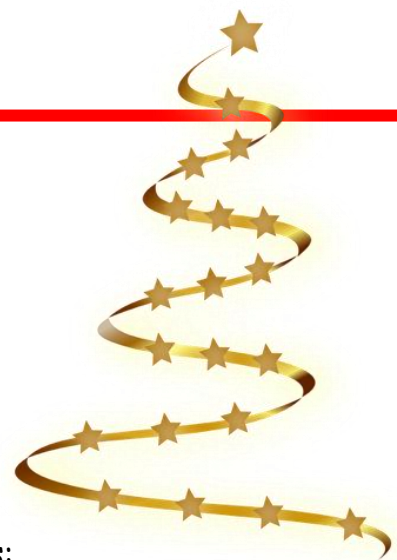
A note of party dates are below:

P1/2 & P2 Tuesday 16th December

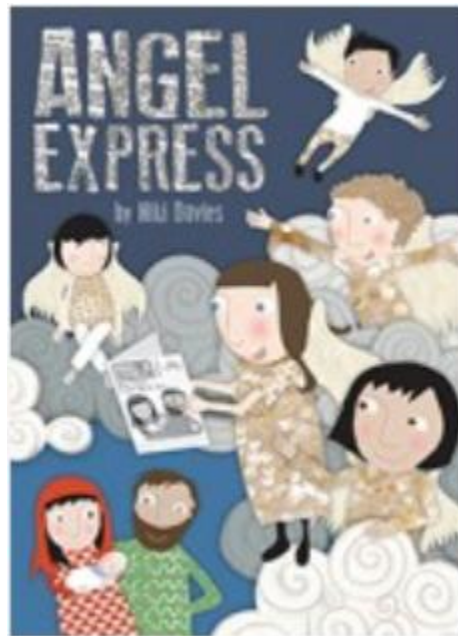


On your child's party day, the arrangements will be as follows:
