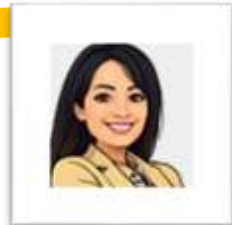

Message from the Head Teacher



Dear Parent/Carers,

It is gearing up to be another busy month at Noble Primary School, with children enjoying a variety of learning experiences and activities.

We have been celebrating World Book Day with a week of fun activities, including the Masked Reader, which saw children stumped trying to identify who some of our mysterious readers were! Our senior pupils also had a series of visits to a local Church where they enjoyed the B.I.B.L.E experience, a fun and interactive way of bringing Religious Education to life! And, Police Scotland also visited last week to kick off our *March Against Racism*, a month of focused learning experiences on anti-racism which we hope will support our efforts to become a more inclusive school.

End of School Day

To help us keep all pupils safe and ensure smooth end of day arrangements, we are updating our pick-up procedures. From Monday 9th March children should not be collected from the front office, unless agreed in advance with the Head Teacher.

If you require an alternative pick-up arrangement, please contact the school office as early as possible so that the Head Teacher can approve and record the change.

This helps us to:

- Maintain accurate safeguarding records
- Avoid confusion at the end of the school day
- Ensure children are released only to authorised adults

We appreciate your understanding and cooperation in keeping our children safe.

Playground Access

This is a polite reminder that parents should not be accessing the playground at any time of the school day; this is a considerable safeguarding issue for us. We ask that you remain at the gates during drop-off and pick-up and that you do not cut through the playground to get from one side of the school to the other. A separate letter will also be issued with further information on playground security.
