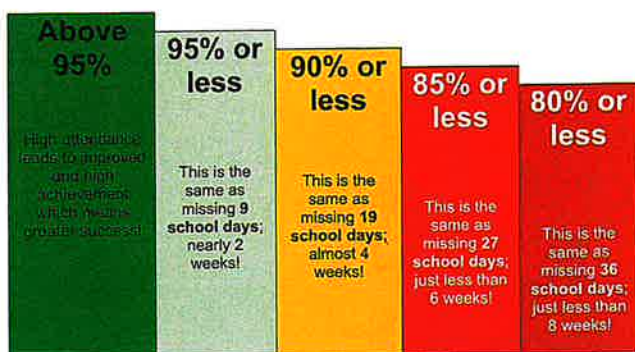
I have the right to get information in lots of ways, as long as it's safe
