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Write a recount about you last birthday. What did you do? How did you feel? Who were you with? When was it? Challenge: Create your own dance routine to a song that you like.
Write out a sequenced set of instructions of how to play 21 with your class mates.	RME: Research Ramadan and list 10 facts about it, and why it is important to Muslims	Chant your times tables 2-12 and ask an adult to test you afterwards. Make sure and chant them up and down the way!	Carry out the literacy challenge set on Sumdog by Miss Miller. These may include your spelling words, or they may be grammar challenges.
Using old food packaging such as cereal boxes and empty bottles from around the house, design and name a robot and create a list of 5 different magical tasks that your robot can perform.	Choose a character from Harry Potter and research them. Write down 10 facts about them, making sure you put the information into your own words. Now draw the character you have chosen.	Play maths games on the internet for 30 minutes. This can be using Sum Dog or Cool Maths Games. Look out for Sumdog challenges!	Help someone at home cook a meal. Write down a set of instructions on what you did, including what ingredients you used and what quantity you needed.
Choose one of the following titles and write your own story. - When the Queen came for tea - The truth about what happened at sea - William and the flying banana	Using your spelling words, carry out the challenges set by Miss Miller on GLOW. These will include capital letter spelling, dotty spelling, pyramid spelling and more! Why not come up with your own type of spelling and show Miss Miller?	Write a fact file for a key figure in British politics. You may choose anyone at all, from the present or the past. What is their job role? What is their key responsibilities and achievements? Where do they work? Remember to put your research into your own words.	Play mathematical Hangman with someone at home. All you need to do is come up with an equation using any of the 4 mathematical operations and the other person has to guess the missing numbers. Eg
Starbucks is trying to create the best Spring/summer smoothie! Create a delicious smoothie that they will want to sell in their stores. What ingredients do you need? Design a poster advertising it, and then create a rival smoothie for Costa and advertise that! Which one would you rather drink?	Using your times tables, create 10 multiplication sums and 10 division calculations and complete them. For example: 3823 x8	You have a budget of £1000. Plan a holiday! Where would you go, and how much would it cost to get there? What about your accommodation? Are there any particular activities you would like to do when you get there? How much do they cost?	Using your 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 or 12 times tables, play a game of bingo with someone at home. Make it more challenging by using more than one of your tables and increasing the number of entries on your bingo card!

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
