- 6. use age appropriate websites and apps that you have permission to be on

- 9. Face the laptop camera during learning and use an appropriate background effect
- 10. When speaking in class use the chat feature and or hands up as directed by the teacher
- 11. show respect for everyone in the online classroom
- 12. seek to contribute to the class in a positive manner and not be disruptive at any time
- 13. not taking screenshots or recording online learning. Doing this could result in you being removed from the learning. Possibly further action being taken.
- 14. report to your school contact if you receive emails that are offensive.
- 15. only copy and use material as allowed by copyright legislation. If you are unsure, you can through Glow contact your school or teacher to ask.
- 16. When using the Internet, working online and sending emails you will ensure you protect yourself and others by not giving out personal information.
- 17. communicating respectfully online e.g. in emails and through Glow for collaborative tasks
- 18. using search engines with care; only searching for information that is related to your learning tasks
- 19. not store any personal details, passwords or bank card details on the device
- 20. not add any new passwords to the school device
