Co-Designing Learning Spaces

The first Cathedral Pupil Parliament theme of the session was **Our Learning & Teaching**, with a specific focus on pupils co-designing learning spaces with their teachers.

At their Class Council meetings on Monday 25th August, pupils across the school were asked: **“What changes or improvements would you like to make to your learning street?”**

Following this, the House Captains met on Wednesday 27th August to discuss the results and update the Action Board, which continued to help Cathedral drive forward change and improvement for all learners.

The **Cabinet Secretaries for Learning**, together with Mrs Mellon and Mr Young, carried out an inspection of the learning streets the following week. During this inspection, they agreed on how Cathedral learners’ suggestions would be actioned.



Counselling Room Makeover

The second Pupil Parliament theme of the session was **Our Health & Wellbeing**, with a specific focus on refurbishing the space used by our school counsellor.

At their Class Council meetings during the week beginning Monday 29th September, learners across the school were asked: **“What changes could we make to the Visiting Services room to make it a more homely space for counselling and quiet meetings?”**

Given that the school counsellor is originally from Denmark, the children were also encouraged to consider what might bring a sense of *hygge* to the room.

Our two **Cabinet Secretaries for Health** led and oversaw the improvement work. They agreed on the colour of the walls, contacted the painter, and ordered new furniture and lighting from Ikea.
