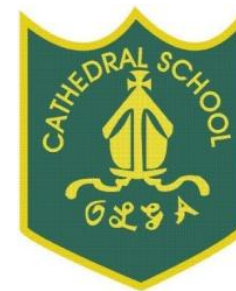

'All children have opportunities to exercise choice in most of their learning activities. All children share confidently what they already know and what they would like to learn more about. They have a deep understanding of their progress in learning. All children identify what and how they would like to learn across the curriculum. For example, each day they choose the order of their tasks, how to undertake a task, and with whom they will learn. All children use knowledge gained in adult-led tasks to help them reflect fully on prior learning.'

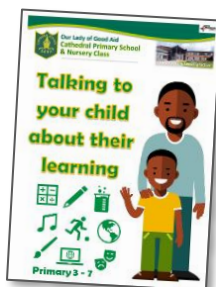

UNIVERSAL FAMILY LEARNING



Cathedral Primary was awarded an '**excellent**' for learning and teaching in its May 2025 inspection. In previous family learning sessions, the focus has been on *how* Cathedral organises and delivers learning and teaching throughout the school day.
