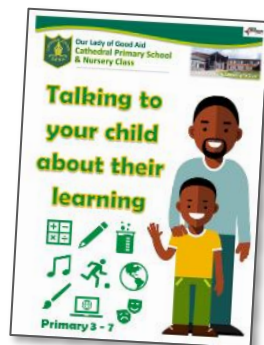
IDL LITERACY AND NUMERACY

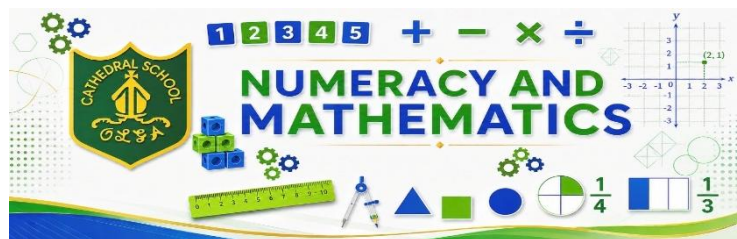

Active8 provides a balanced mix of teacher-led, independent and collaborative learning, with differentiated numeracy and mathematics teaching.
