Parking



Parking is an ongoing issue and we ask that parents park responsibly and safely when dropping off and picking up children. We are very fortunate to have use of the Holy Ghost Fathers car park and the Grotto, and we ask that you use these for parking, but do so considerately.

Please do not use our car park to 'cut through' with your children as it is unsafe to do so.

Time Keeping



Time keeping is an ongoing issue for our school. A significant number of children are not making it into school before the bell every morning. We appreciate that there will be the odd occasion where families will be running a little late for one reason or another but we

ask that you endeavour to get children into school on time as valuable teaching time can be missed. In line with North Lanarkshire policy, we must mark children as 'late' if they are not in school for 9am. If you are arriving with your child after 9am in the morning, please use the main entrance as all other doors will be locked and alarmed. We thank you in advance for your cooperation with this.

Holy Ghost Father Clubs

A number of after school clubs are now being run in the Holy Ghost Fathers' Hall. The individuals who organise these clubs are making arrangements with parents to collect children from our yard and take them next door. We are delighted that children are being afforded additional opportunities to participate in community led clubs, but must stress that this is an arrangement between parents/carers and the clubs concerned. The school cannot take responsibility for ensuring children go to clubs organised by external agencies.

We also ask that they are filled with water before leaving the house in the morning so that children can quickly settle in the classroom. Children have the opportunity to fill up their water bottles throughout the day if they need more.
