## Late Coming

We monitored late comings during the month of February, and on average, 30 pupils are late every day to school. This is $10 \%$ of our overall school roll. On one day alone in February, 72 children were late, which is almost a quarter of our school roll. We must stress again the importance of children coming to school on time. We have included some statistics below highlighting the impact that late coming can have on children's learning:
