

You can read each of the blogs by scrolling down the page and clicking [older posts](#) when you get to the bottom of the page.

Down the right hand page of our blog feed, there is a link to Twitter, and a link to comments that have been made about specific posts.

At the bottom under the heading [Categories](#), there is a link that will take you to your child's specific class. This is particularly useful if you only have a few minutes to look on the blog as it allows you to access posts relevant to your child's learning more quickly. You will also find a tab there that takes you to whole school learning at Orchard too.

If you would like to add a comment to a post that you have liked you can do so by filling in a section at the bottom of that particular post.

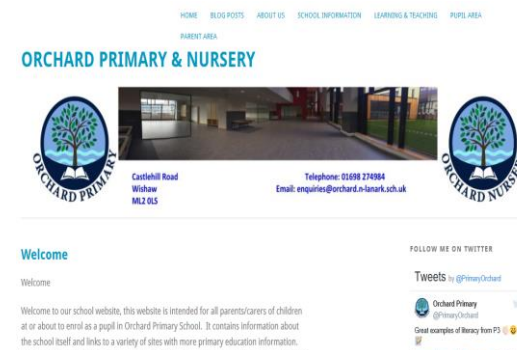
