**Health** This group will look to cover a wide range of health and wellbeing initiatives across the school. This will include Sponsorship days, and Sports Day. It should also try to develop a range of health initiatives through the school across the session and taster days in partnership with school dinners. The group will also promote Mile A Day.



Global Citizenship/Fairtrade This group will have two main focusses: developing the opportunities for Global Learning across our school curriculum and in partnership with RRSA. The group will also lead the work on the school attaining Fairtrade status. They will develop curricular links and organise Fairtrade Fortnight.



**Outdoor Learning** The group will develop the use of our school grounds, look at Charters for play and support all classes in using our outdoor areas effectively. They will also support the work of the Eco committee.



#### Our primary 1 Group:

**Groups through Play** This group will experience elements/skills of all school groups and will do it through the medium of play. This group should work closely with other groups and develop elements of their learning.

### Mrs Woodward's Group

Mrs Woodward will also have an additional group that will meet monthly. This group will have a representative from each class, with a chosen P6 & 7 partnering a P1 & P2. The group will be Learner Improvement Group and will develop work on school policies and learning with Mrs Woodward. Each class rep will feedback to their class monthly.

# **Pupil Voice**



### A broad overview of our groups:



Our Pupil Voice Groups meet on Fridays in blocks of five weeks, from 9.15-10.15am.

Each committee has 2 staff members who support the pupils to take forward the learning in their group.

There are 6 different pupil groups. Children from P2-7 are split across the groups and P1s remain in their class but experience the work of each pupil voice group through play.

Our pupil voice groups are inclusive of both our mainstream and LCSC.

Our groups remain the same for 1 year, to allow for development of events and projects.

Every group takes minutes at their meetings using a Record sheet. Within each pupil voice group we have a chair person, display manager and communications manager.

The display manager's job is to work with their staff members to ensure display areas in our corridors are kept up to date. Communications manager

### **Our 6 Pupil Groups:**

JRSO The group will develop how we come to school safely. Working on a variety of Road safety projects across the session, in line with the authorities Road Safety campaigns.
