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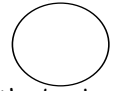

Take **notes** about what has happened in the chapter. Include **key information**, the main points to help summarise the chapter. Make sure most notes are written in your **own words** and include the **page number**. ** You do not need to do all of the bullet points if not necessary**

- Include bullet points and page numbers.
- Use book to help make the notes.

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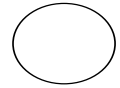
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Summary
