

When the time is up, we are going to share all the ways you have thought of.


We have a responsibility to use it wisely and not waste it. This will help people and all living things throughout our wonderful world.




What difference will doing all we can to make sure we don't waste water really have?

It means that in the future there will still be enough water for having fun with, not just the essentials!







#### Responsible Use




So, we understand the importance of not wasting water. But, how can we put this into action? How can we make sure we are using water responsibly?

Let's be grateful for the access to water we have and show appreciation by doing all we can to use water responsibly.


