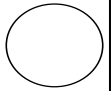

Draw a picture of a different character in the centre of the page and show their role and importance within the story.

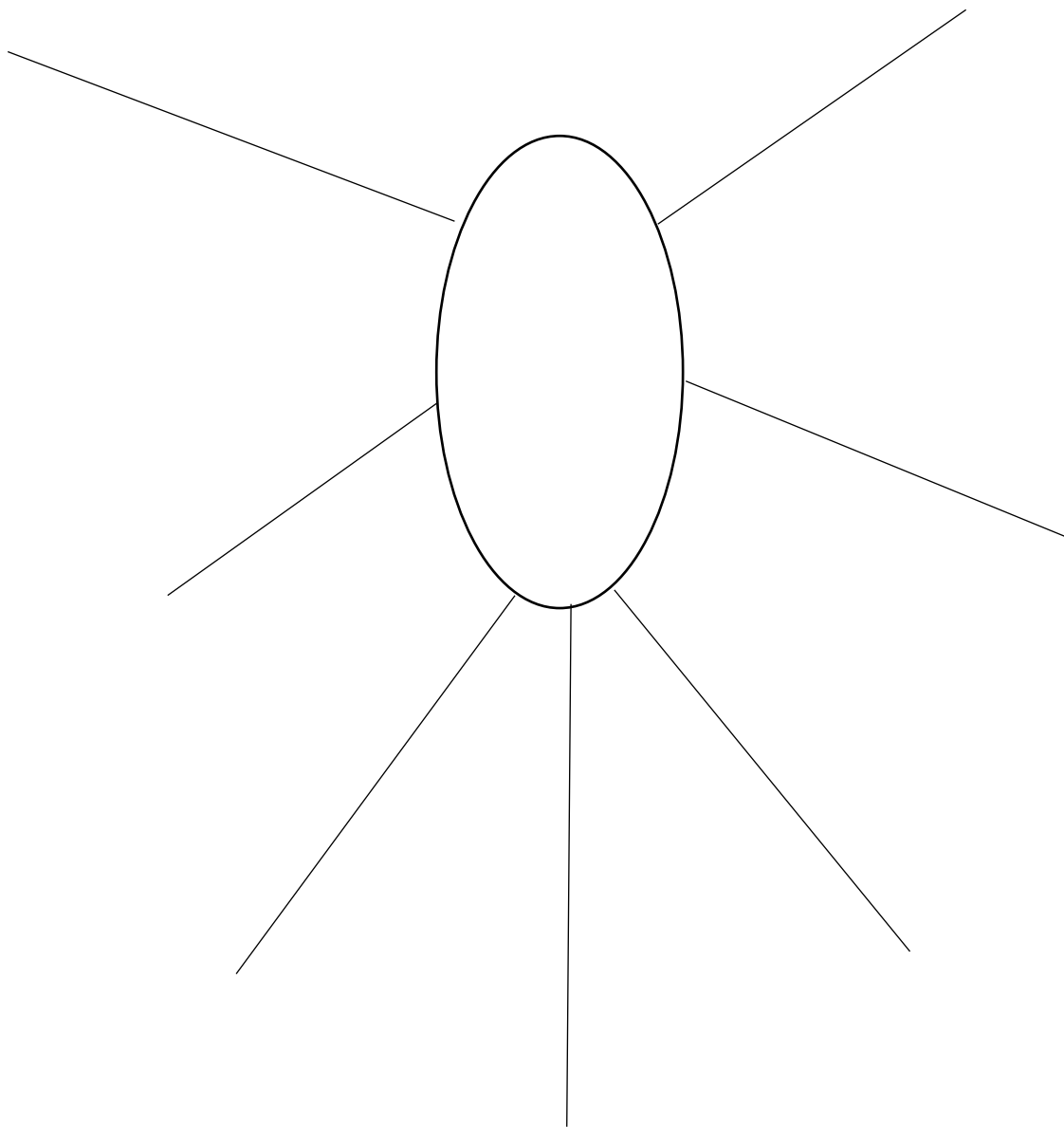
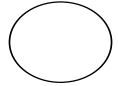

Write a character description about one of the other characters from the book.

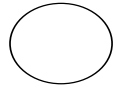

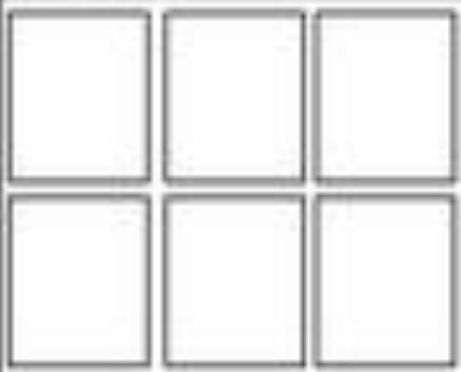

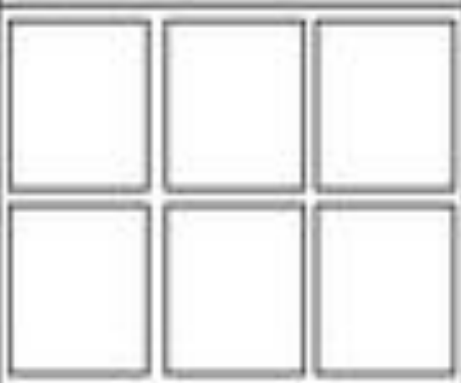
