Storage



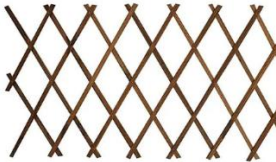
Can also be used to create spaces.

Archway



Can get wooden ones, ones with different heights. Multipurpose: home corners, reading areas, calm spaces, for a particular theme)

Wooden Separator



Can also be used as display e.g. in a message centre with common words & sounds, numbers, environmental print in construction area

Cable Drums (various sizes)



Multipurpose: create tables, play activities, seating area, storage, be used as loose parts, mark making etc.

Pallets



Multipurpose: storage, create areas/activities, tables, benches, dens, loose parts, mud kitchen etc.

Tyres



Multipurpose: storage, activities, loose parts, sand, water, mud, plants, etc.

Logs



Seating area, loose parts, mark making, story circles

Tuff Trays



Can be filled with various resources to invite children to play and extend their learning.

Multipurpose Wooden Frame



Imaginative play, role play- used as shop front, home corner.

Mud Kitchen



Utensils for kitchen, pots and pans, muffin tray, different jars, etc.

Home Corner



Washing machine, Ironing board, cooker, sink area, table, chair, etc.

Trough



Sand, water, mud.

Crates



Indoors as furniture, outdoors for loose parts/tables/stools, etc.

Lap Table



Alternative to using tables all the times, provides flexibility as can be moved to different spaces and by providing a different writing height for children this helps to build strength and endurance to develop fine motor skills.

Wall Mounted White Board



Used for mark making in different zones/areas.

Easel



Furnishings

Mirrors



Home corner, outdoors, role play.

Cushions



Home corner, Library, Calm Area.

Variety of Materials



For draping as canopies, table covers, in tuff trays, creative play, imaginative play, for outdoor play, tarpaulin, etc.

Home Corner Furnishings



Dish rack, fruit bowl, tablecloth, clock, pots and pans, plates, cutlery, cups, rug, vase, plants, pictures, telephone, blankets, measuring equipment (various sizes), curtains, etc.

Lighting



Warm lighting to create calm spaces, small lamps (e.g. home corner), fairy lights.

Fabric Tent



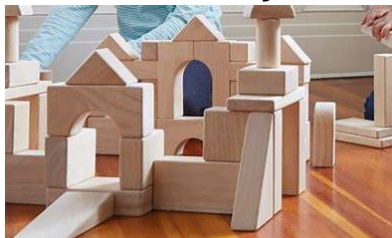
Reading Area, Tent, Cosy Area, Role Play, etc.

Creative Materials

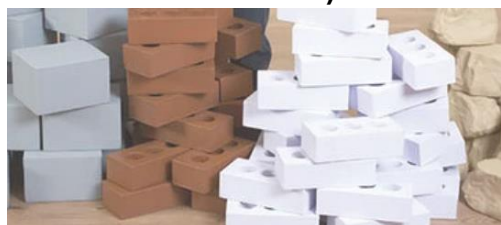


Ribbons, paper, card, mark making materials, wallpaper, buttons, gems, pipecleaners, Play Doh, scissors, rolling pins, printing materials, clay, etc.

Magnetic Construction Tiles



Bricks (different shapes, sizes & materials)



Makedo



Can be used to construct structures using cardboard

Lego



Used in construction, word building, sentence building, Numeracy, make shapes, etc.

Pattern Boards



Practise fine motor skills, make creative patterns/numbers/letters

Peg Boards & Threading



Practise fine motor skills, explore matching/pattern/shape, counting, etc.

Polydron



Indoor and outdoor

Small World



Encourages creative and imaginative play- e.g. storytelling

Loose Parts



A variety of everyday objects to allow exploration and foster creativity and problem solving e.g. bottle tops, sticks, pebbles, shells, fabric scraps, tubes, cubes, old CDs, containers, etc.

Digital Resources

Sphero Indi Robot



Programmable car- open-ended resource that fosters problem solving, critical thinking, computational thinking and basic coding.

Recordable Microphone Buttons



Can use to instruct children and make expectations clear at teacher-initiated activities, to foster Literacy skills- practise phonics, practise fluency.

Beebots



Programmable robots- fosters problem solving, critical thinking, computational thinking and basic coding.

Other

Guttering



For water channels, rolling objects, designing and building structures, etc.

Role Play Accessories



Multipurpose (rather than just costume sets): hats, shoes, bags, binoculars, magnifying glasses, tools, a variety of materials, items/objects that enhance role play, props, baskets for transporting/storage, etc. (can ask for donations)

Tinkering



Old keyboards, phones, toys, cars, etc. that can be taken apart to allow children to tinker.
Tools: different sized equipment (nuts, bolts, screws, screwdrivers, pliers, etc.)

Music Area



Pots, pans, grills, wooden/metal spoons, tubes, old musical instruments, etc.
