Literacy Workshop

This year we will be holding two Literacy workshops on Wednesday 16th November (PLEASE NOTE THAT THIS IS A CHANGE OF DATE FROM THE DIARY DATES ISSUED AT THE START OF TERM). The morning session will start at 9.30am and the evening session will kick off at 6.30pm. At these workshops we will be sharing our Active Literacy

programme with you and giving you lots of opportunities to see it in action with our pupils. Mrs Hawthorn and Mrs Wilson will start the hour off by explaining the reasons why we teach Literacy the way we do. Following their welcome you will have the chance to watch a model lesson delivered by our class teachers and involving some volunteer pupils. If you choose to attend the morning session there will only be one model lesson as the rest of the teachers will be in class but if you come along to the evening session you will be able to move between the classes and see different strategies in reading and spelling being taught. This workshop will support parents and carers of all learners, no matter what class they are in, to better understand the skills they are developing in school and how they progress. You will also have the chance to look at the resources in use here at Ravenswood and find out about how you can best support your child's literacy learning.
