The Rainbow Fish asked:

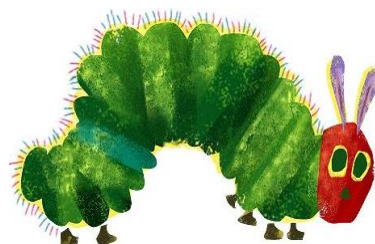
"Will I be able to share my shiny scales and toys?"



Answer – It is kind to share but to keep everyone safe we can't share our own things. So we must keep our pens, pencils and snacks to ourselves. We will be able to share again soon, your teacher will let you know when you can do this.

The Very Hungry Caterpillar asked:

"I like to bring my own food to school. Can I bring a packed lunch to school with me?"



Answer – Yes, you can bring a packed lunch from home or you can get lunch from the cafeteria. You can bring a snack for break time too.

Room on the Broom animals asked:

“Can we sit next to our friends?”



Answer – Yes, as long as they are in the same class as you. You can sit next to friends, and play with friends who are in the same class as you. To keep everyone safe we should try to keep our hands to ourselves. This means we shouldn't pop bubbles and instead keep hugs and hand holding for our families at home.

The Mouse asked:

“Do I have to wash my hands before eating my Gruffalo Crumble?”

Answer – Yes. Everyone will be washing their hands more often. You will wash your hands with soap and water before break times, lunch times and after playing. Your teacher will let you know when you need to wash your hands.



Harry and his Bucket Full of Dinosaurs asked:

“I love my bucket of dinosaurs. Can I bring them to school to play with?”
